## MASTER PEDIGREE DATABASE

---

Our Master Pedigree Database is a combination of original research and information from members pedigrees. Recently 165,000 names, related to birth, marriage, and deaths from central Poland records, were added to the database. Combined with the pedigrees from the membership, the total number of entries is now nearly 449,000 names.

The major feature of this database is that it is in a family format. Family members are linked; therefore, if you find one member of a family, you will probably find several other members of the same family.

## JOURNAL

---

A Journal is published quarterly and distributed via the Internet to members having Internet access and via regular mail to those members not yet on the Internet.

The Journal contains society information, articles on family histories and lifestyles of our ancestors, current research projects, convention information and the like.
