Substantiated Alternate surnames found in the SGGEE Master Pedigree Database- 24 February 2014

The following list of **substantiated** alternate surnames is found in the **SGGEE Master Pedigree Database**. **They have been confirmed by sources other than personal family records**. Names followed by + are from Oskar Kossmann's "Die Deutschen in Polen", printed in 1978. Names that are followed by an * were provided courtesy of Reiner Kerp via the SGGEE mail list. Names provided by persons unknown are followed by a 1. Names supplied by Al Muth are followed by a 2. Names provided by Reiner Kerp in a February 21, 2003 posting on the SGGEE listserv are followed by a 3. Names followed by a 4 provided by Karl Krueger from Lublin indexing project.

Note that none of the name variations below include the substitution of an ä for ae, an ö for oe, a ü for ue, or a ß for ss, but those are yet other variations of the names listed below. Also note that none of the Polish language diacritical marks are included in the following alternates, so those are yet other variations of many of the names listed that you may encounter in the original records.

There are many other variations of these names in the SGGEE database that are not shown as alternates here, because those alternates have not been provided by other than personal family records. See the separate Alternate Surnames from Family Records File for those names.

Even if you do not see an alternate name listed for the surname you are checking in this list, pay attention to the variations in the other names to get an idea of how your surname might be transformed on a record that you have not yet seen, or have seen but did not comprehend was the same surname you seek. Also pay attention to the variations in the adjoining names that are similar to the surname you seek.

The reasons for the alternate names below seem to exist for at least the following reasons:

1. There was a real name change (either a small or large spelling variation or an outright and complete change that is not connected to the previous name)
2. The German name was converted to a Polish or Russian or English equivalent
